

Ausiàs Garrigós

Ausiàs Garrigós Morant es el clarinete bajo solista y clarinete asistente de la Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra.

Es profesor de clarinete bajo y clarinete en el Royal Northern College of Music de Manchester y en la Guildhall School of Music & Drama de Londres. También imparte masterclases regularmente en conservatorios como el Royal College of Music de Londres y el Conservatori del Liceu de Barcelona.

Colabora frecuentemente con orquestas como la London Symphony Orchestra, BBC Symphony Orchestra, Sinfonia of London, Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, Chamber Orchestra of Europe, Orquestra del Gran Teatre del Liceu, Orquestra de la Comunitat Valenciana, entre otras.

Es miembro fundador del Riot Ensemble, un grupo especializado en música contemporánea, y director artístico del Potries Music Fest.

Estudió en el Conservatorio Superior de Música de Castellón, y amplió su formación con el Master de especialización orquestal en la Guildhall School de Londres con los profesores Andrew Marriner, Julian Farrell, Lorenzo Losco, Juan Estaban Romero, Johannes Peitz i Francisco Javier Ros.

He is a professor of bass clarinet and clarinet at the Royal Northern College of Music in Manchester and at the Guildhall School of Music & Drama in London. He frequently collaborates with orchestras such as the London Symphony Orchestra, BBC Symphony Orchestra, Sinfonia of London, Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, Chamber Orchestra of Europe, Orquestra del Gran Teatre del Liceu, Orquestra de la Comunitat Valenciana, among others.

He is also a founding member of the Riot Ensemble, a group specialized in contemporary music, and artistic director of the Potries Music Fest.
